OBITUARY.

The death occurred at his residence at Kendall on Sunday last, at the age of 81 years, of Mr. George Aldridge, well known on the Macleay River (says the "Macleay Argus"). A son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Aldridge, of Rollands Plains, deceased was born there. At the age of 10 years he came to the Macleay River, and proceeded to Mount Moparabah, where he was employed by the late Mr. W. D. Scott until he was 22 years of age. He then proceeded to Port Macquarie, where some time after he met and married Miss Marie Upsall, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. W. Upsall, of that township. He then took his bride to Kendall, just on 58 years ago, where he engaged in farming and the timber trade, which he continued until some three years back, when he retired. He is survived by his widow, three daughters, Mesdames W. Evans (South Kempsey), A. Northam (Taree) and H. McCafferty (Picton), and seven sons, Messrs. Alfred (Kendall), Frank (Upsall's Creek), Thomas and Douglas (Lorne), Len and Alvie (Kendall), and Alex (Kendall). One son, Leslie, predeceased his father 22 years ago. Mr. William Aldridge (Sydney) is a brother of the deceased. The funeral took place on Monday from the Kendall Church of England, where Rev. Melville, an old friend of deceased, officiated at a service at which he paid tribute to deceased's life work. Rev. Melville officiated at the Kendall cemetery in the presence of a large assemblage of relatives and friends.

FALLING LIMB KILLED MAN

Mr. Leonard Arthur Aldridge, 58, of Fagan Crescent, Kendall, died in the Hastings District Hospital on Tuesday night, after the limb of a tree had fallen on him that day.

Aldridge was working in the State Forest at Comboyne; a falling limb from 50 feet up struck him end on, on the head smashing the safety helmet which he was wearing.

He suffered severe head injuries; first aid was given by a workmate, then by a doctor, and Aldridge was conveyed to hospital by ambulance, after being carried for a distance of 300 yards.

CORNELIUS Alex Aldridge died in the Wauchope Hospital on July 23, aged 75 years. A service was held in the Anglican Church on July 25 prior to interment in the Wauchope Lawn Cemetery. Mr Aldridge is survived by his wife, Clarice, and stepson Wayne Wellings and family of Kempsey.
