THOMAS TROTTER WAS BORN AT PERTH, ON THE FIRTH OF TAY IN SCOTLAND IN 1794. THE SON OF JOHN AND JANE TROTTER (NEE WHITELY).

THOMAS WAS WELL EDUCATED. AS A YOUNG MAN HE SHOWED A GREAT INTEREST IN HORTICULTURE AND NURSERY WORK. HE WAS SENT TO ENGLAND WHERE HE UNDERWENT A THOROUGH TRAINING IN THESE SUBJECTS.

HE WENT TO NORTH WALES WHERE HE MARRIED MARY TILSTON AT GRESFORD, ON THE 7TH OF OCTOBER 1817 AND SETTLED DOWN FOR THE NEXT EIGHTEEN YEARS. IT WAS DURING THIS TIME THAT HE CAME UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF THE METHODIST (WESLEYAN) REVIVAL WHICH SWEEPED THROUGH WALES, AND THUS THE STRONG RELIGIOUS CONVICTIONS OF THE FAMILY WERE ESTABLISHED.

FROM WALES HE CROSSED THE SEA TO IRELAND. IT WAS HERE THAT THE URGE TO EMIGRATE TO AUSTRALIA CAME TO HIM. (HIS ELDEST SON JOHN, HAD ALREADY MADE THE VOYAGE IN 1834, ACTING AS A VALET IN BISHOP BROUGHTON'S HOUSEHOLD.) THE OPPORTUNITY CAME UNEXPECTEDLY, HE WAS ACQUAINTED WITH MR. BOYDELL, A SHAREHOLDER AND ONE OF THE OFFICIALS OF THE AUSTRALIAN AGRICULTURAL COMPANY. MR. BOYDELL WROTE TO THOMAS TROTTER ASKING HIM TO COME TO AUSTRALIA TO LAY OUT ORCHARDS FOR THE COMPANY. INCLUDED IN THE DEAL WAS THE OFFER OF THE LEASE OF LAND, SO THAT THOMAS MAY MAKE A START FOR HIMSELF.

THOMAS TROTTER, THEN 42 YEARS OF AGE WITH A FAMILY OF SIX STILL AT HOME, INCLUDING AN INFANT, MADE ARRANGEMENTS TO COME OUT, THEY DEPARTED FROM CORK, IRELAND ON MAY 26TH 1836 ABOARD THE 'DUCHESS OF NORTHUMBERLAND' AND AFTER A STORMY AND EVENTFUL VOYAGE ARRIVED IN AUSTRALIA ON OCTOBER 3RD 1836.

THE FAMILY FIRST WENT TO THE DUNOGG DISTRICT AND SETTLED IN THE LOCALITY OF BANDON GROVE, LATER MOVING TO THE UPPER PART OF THE WILLIAMS RIVER, AT CHICHESTER, WHERE THE LAND WAS EMINENTLY SUITABLE FOR FRUIT GROWING.

ON THE 21ST OF OCTOBER 1851, THOMAS TROTTER AND WILLIAM PLUMMER (OF THE MANNING RIVER) JOINTLY PURCHASED 'GLENTHORNE ESTATE' OF 647 ACRES FROM JAMES CORLETTE, FOR THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY POUNDS. CORLETTE HAD PREVIOUSLY BOUGHT THE LAND FROM THE CROWN AT PUBLIC AUCTION IN 1841 FOR THREE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY EIGHT POUNDS FOUR SHILLINGS. THE ESTATE WAS SUBDIVIDED ON DECEMBER THE 16TH 1852 AND PORTIONS SOLD TO JAMES ROBINSON, ROBERT BELFORD AND ALFRED BLACKFORD. THOMAS TROTTER SENIOR AND HIS SONS RETAINED THE REMAINDER FOR THEIR OWN HOMES.

THE REMOVAL OF THESE FAMILIES TO 'GLENTHORNE' WAS A MOST TRYING ORDEAL IN ITSELF. FOR A GREAT PART OF THE DISTANCE THE ROAD CONSISTED OF LITTLE MORE THAN A BRIDLE TRACK, AND THE FIRST ARRIVALS HAD TO TRAVEL TO REDBANK, PARTS OF WHICH WERE ALREADY SETTLED, NOTABLY THE BUTCHERY BUSINESS OF CHARLES TURNER, WHO LIVED ON THE RIVER BANK ALMOST OPPOSITE 'GLENTHORNE'. THE PARTY HAD TO BE CONVEYED BY BOAT ACROSS TO 'GLENTHORNE'. THERE WERE MANY DIFFICULTIES, IN NUMEROUS PLACES TRACKS HAD TO BE CUT, RIVERS WERE FLOODED AND DAYS WERE LOST IN WAITING FOR THEM TO RECEDE, AND IT WAS ONLY AFTER WEEKS OF TOIL AND ANXIETY, WITH DWINDLING STORES, THAT AT LAST THEY ARRIVED AT THE PROMISED LAND. THOMAS TROTTER HAD BROUGHT WITH HIM MANY SEEDLINGS AND GRAFTED TREES, AS WELL AS SEEDS AND ONE OF HIS FIRST LABOURS ON HIS OWN AND HIS SONS' HOMESTEADS WAS THE PLANTING OF AN ORCHARD ON THE NEWLY CLEARED LAND. ORANGES WERE THE PREDOMINANT CROP AND FOR THE NEXT FIFTY YEARS, GLENTHORNE WAS NOTED FOR ITS ORANGES.

THE WESLEYAN (METHODIST) RELIGION HAD ITS FIRST SERVICES ON THE MANNING RIVER, IN 1854. THESE WERE HELD IN THE HOME OF THOMAS TROTTER, AT GLENTHORNE, THEY WERE PREACHED BY ROBERT 'BISHOP' BELFORD. THE TROTTER FAMILY REMAINED CLOSELY CONNECTED WITH THE WESLEYAN CAUSE, AT LEAST THREE OF THE TROTTER BOYS WERE LAY PREACHERS, AND THE WHOLE FAMILY MADE MEANINGFUL CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARD THE BUILDING OF THE GLENTHORNE CHAPEL WHICH WAS OPENED ON NOVEMBER 15TH 1857. THE FAMILY TRADITION HAS CONTINUED IN SOME BRANCHES, AS 102 YEARS LATER IN 1959, AT LEAST TWO OF THE THREE TRUSTEES OF THE GLENTHORNE CHAPEL, R. TROTTER AND W. MUSCIO, WERE DESCENDANTS OF THOMAS TROTTER SENIOR.

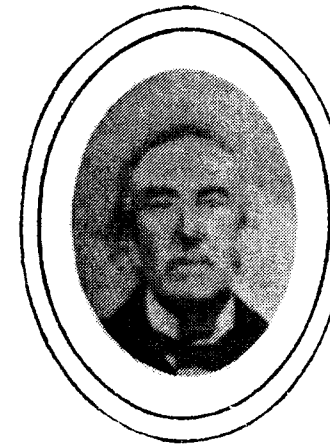
ROBERT 'BISHOP' BELFORD HAS A DEEPER CONNECTION WITH THE TROTTER FAMILY. SIX OF HIS SEVEN CHILDREN MARRIED CHILDREN OR GRANDCHILDREN OF THOMAS TROTTER, UNITING THE FAMILIES IN FACT AS WELL AS IN BELIEF.

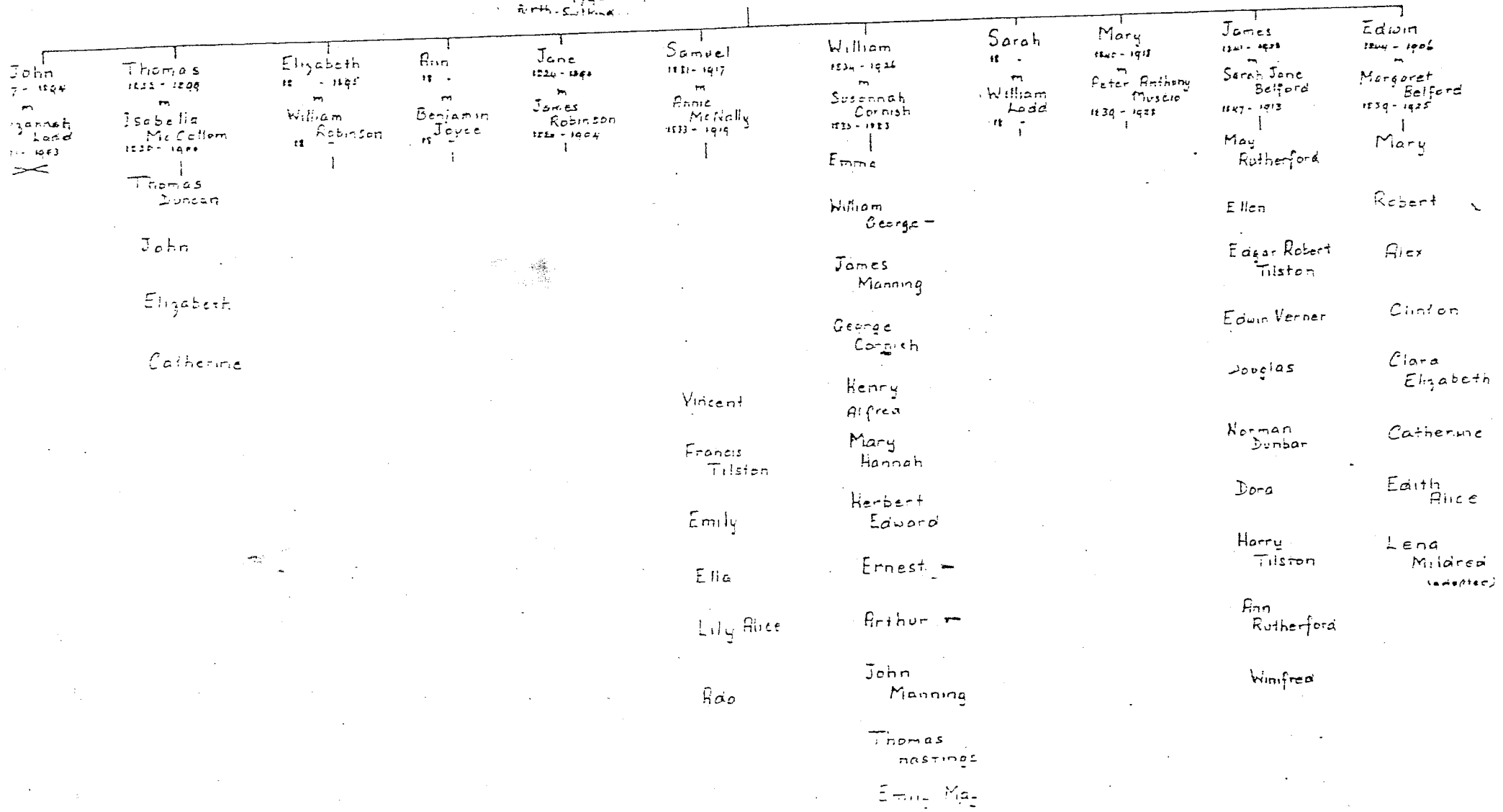

I regret to say that Mrs. W. Trotter is not improving as fast as her friends would like. She is still under Dr. Gormley's care at Taree.

MRS. MARY POLLEY.

On Tuesday last, at 4 p.m., the death occurred of Mrs. Mary Polley, relict of the late Mr. James Polley, who died some eight years ago. Deceased who was 75 years of age, was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. William Trotter and was born at Dingo Creek. While a child she went with her parents and other members of the family to live at Glenthorne and later the family moved to the Hastings River, where she was married to her late husband, Mr. James Polley. They lived for a time at Woodside, and then moved to Beechwood, on the Hastings River, some 18 years ago, where her husband died. From then on deceased spent the most of the remainder of her life on the Manning. For a time she lived with Mrs. J. McPherson (cousin), of Wingham. Shortly before Christmas the late Mrs Polley went to live with her sister (Mrs James Mathers, of Cundle), where on Christmas Day, she had a seizure. Following that she was treated in Taree private hospital for a fortnight. Following that she resided with her sister-in-law (Mrs. Trotter, of Albert St., Taree) at whose home she passed away as stated. The late Mrs. Polley lived a good Christian life and was universally respected wherever she lived. She was a member of Wingham Methodist Ladies' Church Aid. She did not leave any family. Mrs. James Mathers, (Cundle) is the only living sister, while surviving brothers are Messrs Herbert Trotter (Port Macquarie), Ernest (Beechwood), and Jack (Terrigal). A deceased sister is Mrs. F. Joyce (Rollands Plains); while deceased brothers are Messrs William Trotter (Beechwood), George (Huntingdon), Alfred, Arthur and Thomas (Beechwood), James (Martin's Creek) and Harry (Euroka).

The funeral took place on Wednesday, after a service at 2.30 at Mr. W. T. Howard's Funeral Parlor Taree, conducted by the Rev. C. H. Buttsworth (Wingham) and Rev. E. W. Hyde (Taree), who also completed the burial service in the Methodist portion of the Dawson Cemetery. Mr. W. T. Howard was the undertaker. —M. R. Times.

MRS. E. M. MATHERS

(e) With the passing of Emily May Mathers on May 20, at the age of 78 years, another link with early pioneering days was broken.

She was the youngest child of the late William and Sarahannah Trotter, who moved from the Williams River by bullock dray, about 109 years ago, to settle at Glenthorne, where she was born. At an early age she moved with her parents to the Hastings River district, where she lived for many years.

Later moving to Cundletown she married Mr. James P. Mathers.

Since the death of her husband in 1941 she resided in Taree.

Both at Beechwood and Cundletown, Mrs. Mathers took a very active part in the work of her church, being a Sunday School teacher, and member of the Ladies' Church Aid, and taking part in other church activities until her health failed.

Mrs. Mathers and her husband were noted for their hospitality, and ministrations were always a welcome at the Mathers' home in Cundletown.

She was the youngest of a family of thirteen, Emma predeceased her, name of Mrs. Frank Joyce, William, James, Alfred, Henry, George, Mary (Mrs. James Polley), Ernest, Arthur, Herbert, John and Thomas.

Mrs. M. H. Trotter, of Albert Street, Taree, is the late Thomas Trotter's only surviving sister-in-law.

The remains were laid to rest in the Dawson Cemetery after a service in Taree Methodist Church, and the esteem in which she was held was evidenced by the number of relatives who attended, many coming from a distance to pay their last respects.

19-1-1921 H.S.G.

A son of Mr. Alf. Trotter, of Bellangry, whilst on the way to Watchope with pigs in a cart, met with a nasty accident through being thrown from the cart and the horses bolting. The reins got entangled round his leg causing him to be pulled along the road for a considerable distance under the cart. Fortunately the wheel never went over him, but he was badly cut and bruised. He was removed from Mr. J. Lyne's after being attended to by Dr. Begg, who brought him in to the local hospital where he is progressing favourably.

H.S.G. 20-12-1921

James Cornish was a private in the Royal Staff Corps and served with No 3 Company of that Corps between the end of 1825 and mid 1829. His time of arrival in NSW can be deduced from the Pay & Muster Rolls in WO 12 and microfilms of these are available in National and State Libraries. The Reel Number for the Royal Staff Corps is 3917. These Rolls were usually completed quarterly and showed the soldier's pay and/or location on a monthly basis. James was given a veteran's grant of 45 acres on 8 Aug. 1829 at Maitland. He mortgaged the land which was taken over by Edward Sparkes Junior in 1840. During the 1840s Cornish was living at Hexham and in 1854 he was at Bendolba near Dungog. The Royal Staff Corps were not soldiers in the strict sense of the word but were skilled or semi skilled tradesmen who worked on public works projects. The Corps was

finally disbanded in England in 1833 when their kind of duties were taken over by the Royal Corps of Sappers & Miners, later the Royal Engineers. The R.S.C. did some good work in NSW and Tasmania between 1826 and 1829 building bridges, court houses, government offices and hotels. The town of Oatlands in Tasmania was built entirely by them and when the Company was disbanded all settled there.

Unfortunately the personal records of R.S.C. Men are hard to come by because most of them were destroyed during the bombing of London in 1941. The Description Book was also lost.

Private James Cornish:

He joined the Company (No 3) at Sydney in mid 1827. He was a tradesman Class III and his rate of pay was nine pence a day. This would have been a penny a day more than an infantry soldier of similar army rank. In addition he had free rations, which an infantryman did not, a free complete new uniform every two years and was not subject to the harsh discipline of infantry or cavalry. He was stationed at Sydney for his entire service and was discharged on 20 June 1829. His grant of 45 acres at West Maitland was authorised on the 8th August of the same year but his name did not disappear from the Pay Roll until September 1829. From then he was given free rations for the next twelve months and his wife half rations! After that time they were expected to produce their own food.

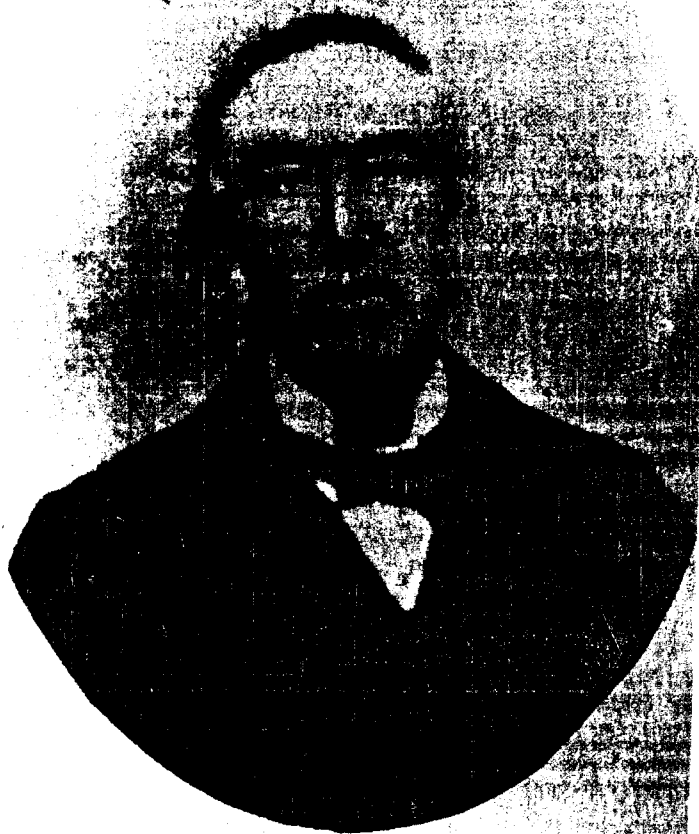
The 1841 census shows Jas Cornish as a stone-mason by trade; this fits in with his army trade classification.
