

Chapter 1

WILLIAM AND CORDELIA

It was in the English seaside town of Winchelsea, in the southern county of Sussex, that a son, William, was born to William and Mary Martin (nee Jones) in 1806. Little did William and Mary know that baby William would be the one to take the family name to the new land down under, and be the patriarch of a family, now numbering into the thousands. Not a great deal is known of William's childhood or teenage years, except that as a young man he followed in his father's footsteps and became a farm labourer. He had some basic education and could read and write.

In 1829, at the age of twenty-three, he married Cordelia Sinden, daughter of John and Jan Sinden, who was then just nineteen years old. Their first child, a boy, was also named William, and he was followed by daughters Mary, Ann and Sarah. The real reason for the family's emigration is not known, maybe it was insecurity of employment, maybe it was the stories of opportunity and promises of prosperity filtering through from the new colony of New South Wales, but whatever the reason, emigrate they did, sailing from Plymouth on 14th June, 1838, on the "Coromandel," the children then being aged nine, six, four and one and a half years, and after a journey lasting three and a half months, landed at Sydney on 2nd October, 1838.

There were four hundred emigrants on the "Coromandel," as well as cabin passengers, and an outbreak of smallpox caused the death of four adults and eleven children. There were also reported cases of whooping cough and scurvy. All passengers were Wesleyan, and in later years were known as "Coromandelites." Among the personal luggage of William and Cordelia was a portrait of the Reverend John Wesley, and a christening goblet, which was turned from part of an old ash tree from Winchelsea, under which Wesley preached his last sermon in the open air. The portrait now hangs in the Uniting Church at Burrell Creek, as it has done for fifty-three years and the goblet is in possession of Ray Martin of Guyra.

The family's emigration was sponsored by a Mr. Marshall of Sydney, who had a job available for William on arrival. How long William, Cordelia and children spent in Sydney is not known, but it could not have been very long before they moved to the Williams River, because their eight youngest children were all born in that general area, the youngest of them on 24th December, 1854. Birth certificates indicate that the births took place at Singleton, Bandon Grove, Wyleys Flat, Upper Allyn River, Williams River and Clarencetown.

The family home was for a time at Bandon Grove and then at Chichester River. They were at Chichester River when William gave his consent for their daughter Ann to marry Alfred Richardson (see page 39). It is not known if William actually owned the land on which he lived and worked on the Williams River, but in the writing of a Manning pioneer, Peter Anthony Muscio, the writer recalls working for a William Martin at Bandon Grove, threshing wheat, chipping tobacco and milking cows. If he did not own the land, perhaps it was a clearing lease he held, which was a common means of tenure in those days.

On 24th February, 1853, Mary, the eldest daughter, was married to Thomas Avery at Seaham. The following year Tom and Mary moved north to settle on the Manning, where Tom established a flour mill. Three years later William and Cordelia and other members of the family made the move to the Manning. The journey was made by bullock dray. Again we do not know what prompted the move to the Manning but presumably they were encouraged to do so by Mary who would certainly have conveyed some good reports of the developing Manning Valley to them.

They made their home at "Kelvin Grove" and although no trace of the house is now evident, the exact location is well known, and the property is now owned by Ken Martin, great-grandson of William and Cordelia. William and Cordelia spent the rest of their lives at "Kelvin Grove." William died on 15th November, 1876 and Cordelia on 9th June, 1894. They are buried in the Uniting Church portion of the Tinonee Cemetery (see photograph).




SECOND GENERATION

William Martin was the eldest child of William and Cordelia Martin. He was born in England in 1829 and came to Australia with his parents on the "Coromandel" in 1838.

On June 23, 1859, William married Ann Frazier, daughter of Thomas Frazier, at "Kelvin Grove," Burrell Creek, on the Manning River. They had a large family of sixteen children — however, two children, Thomas and James died during childhood. William and Ann spent the first thirteen years of married life in the Manning River and Hastings River districts, where several of their children were born. In 1872, William and Ann moved to the Armidale district, and selected a property west of Saumarez Ponds where Ann's parents, Thomas and Sarah Frazier, had a property called "Deeping Grove." William and Ann called their property "Hillwood" and this property was synonymous with the Martin families for many, many years.

William and Ann spent the rest of their lives at "Hillwood." William died in 1912 and Ann died in 1914. They are both buried in the Frazier family cemetery at Saumarez Ponds.

A look through the pages of history

The accompanying photograph of a dapper young gentleman of obvious means, attired in a single breasted three piece suit of quality cloth, was a studio portrait of the Falk Studios, 496 George Street, Sydney (Phone 1141) and was probably taken in the early 1890's when the subject was about 25 years of age.

Born at Glen Innes in 1866, Francis George Martin was the eldest son of James and Matila (nee Hetherington), the remainder of the family being Walter H. born in 1868, Alex Reginald (1870), Arthur Harold (1872), Mabel Isabella (1875), Sydney Edgar (1877), Edith Margaret (1880) and Laura M (1879).

Francis Martin joined the staff of the Bank of New South Wales and was transferred to Port Macquarie in 1889 as an accountant, serving under the manager, William John MacDonnell at premises in Clarence Street and later at their new building at 35 Horton Street.

As a young and influential man about town, Frank was involved in almost every organisation which existed during his time here — Secretary of the Cricket Club, Lawn Tennis Club, Bicycle Club and the Athletic Club, Treasurer of the School of Arts, St Thomas parochial Council, Volunteer Rifles, President of the Dramatic Society, auditor of the Agricultural and Horticultural Association and a member of the Port Macquarie Band, Masonic Lodge and Independent Order of Good Templars.

His younger brother, Sydney Edgar, enlisted with the 1st NSW Mounted Infantry and was a Corporal during the Boer War of 1899-1902, being invalided home to Australia on October 8, 1901. Three of his letters from the front to his brothers were published by the Port Macquarie News, an extract from one describing a mounted charge against the Boers: "We at length reached the Kopje and got out of rifle fire. Dismounting, we then commenced the ascent and very shortly we heard the horrible sounds of explosive bullets cracking against the rocks behind us.

Allan Cameron from Glen Innes was the first to fall, being shot through the stomach. Lt Harriott turned around and gave us the order to take Allan away, when he fell with a horrible groan, being shot through the leg with an explosive bullet. The bone was completely shattered and the Lt. died the same night. Lt Drage then gave a yell and jumped up into the air, shot through the brain — he died in a few moments. Then Pte Murray of the 2nd Contingent dropped, being shot through the mouth. We now fixed bayonets and went for them..."

Frank Martin was promoted manager of the Emmaville branch of the bank and left Port Macquarie in August 1901, later being transferred to Walgett. In February 1907, he returned to Port Macquarie for a holiday.
